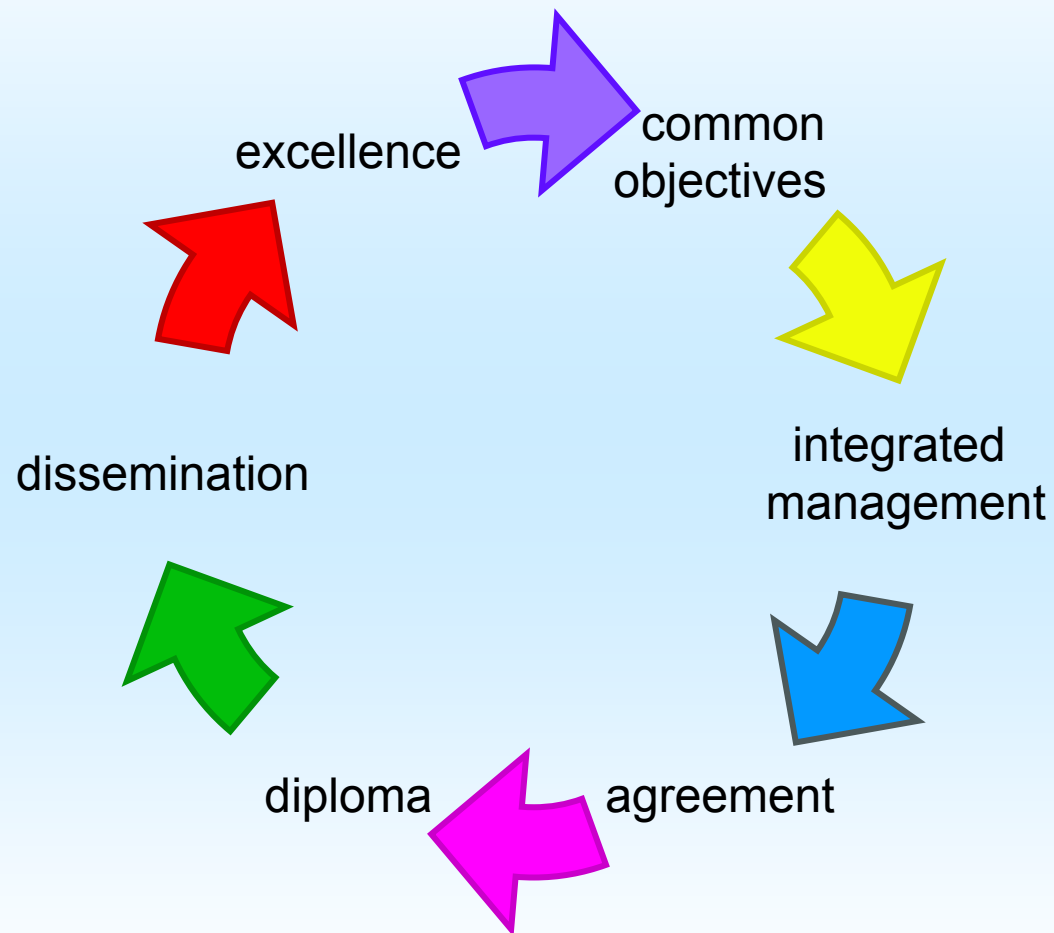

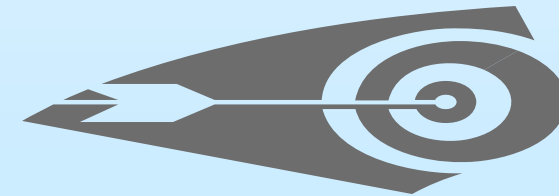

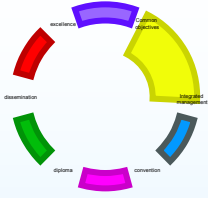
Common objectives

- **European training acknowledged as internationally**



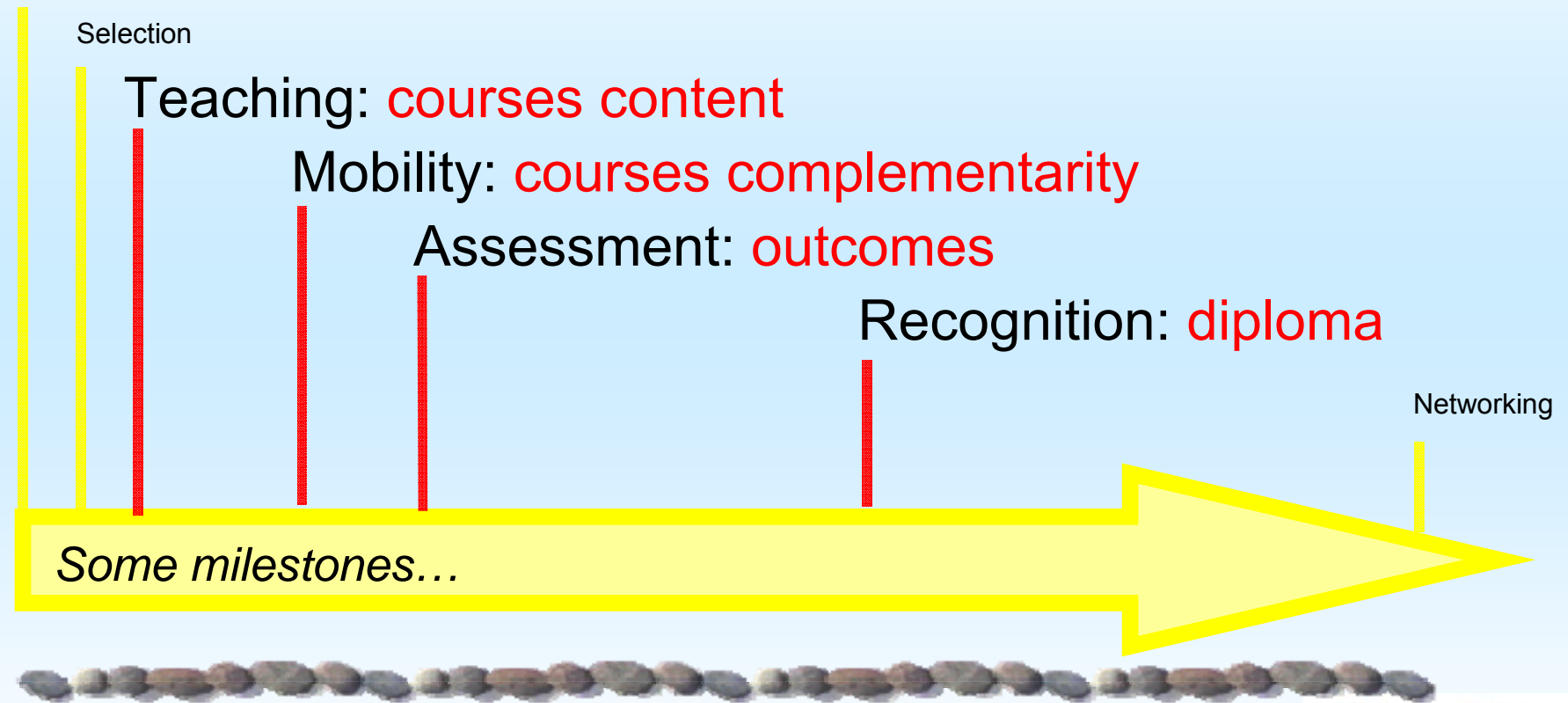
Valid (competencies/learning outcomes)

Teaching: **courses content**

Theoretical training /	Practical training
Mandatory courses /	Elective courses
Single curriculum /	Tracks

Mobility: **courses complementarity**

- ◆ Consortium responsible for mobility coherence
 - Coordinator / Track leader
 - Institution contact persons
- ◆ Each institution responsible for courses coherence
 - Institution contact persons
 - Other local departements



Integrated management 3/3

Assessment: **outcomes**

BASIS: Common criteria (see selection)

COORDINATE: Staff cross-participation in assessing

JOINT: Dedicated assessment with relevant members involved

Recognition: **diploma process**

No European or International Official Diploma Authority

EM label based on YOUR accreditation

Tune different rules

Balanced agreements 2/2

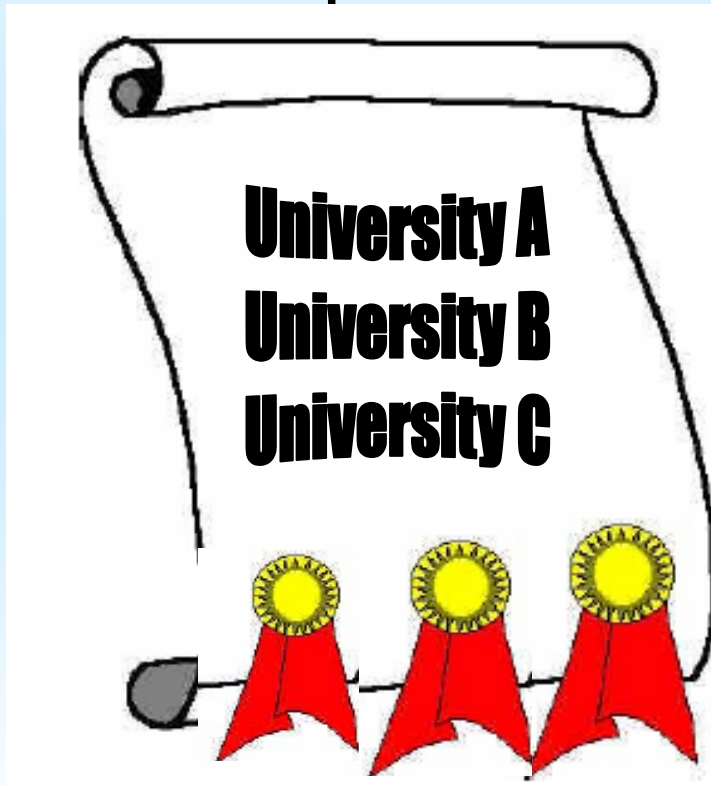
- **Courses Management Content**

 - Procedure of revision



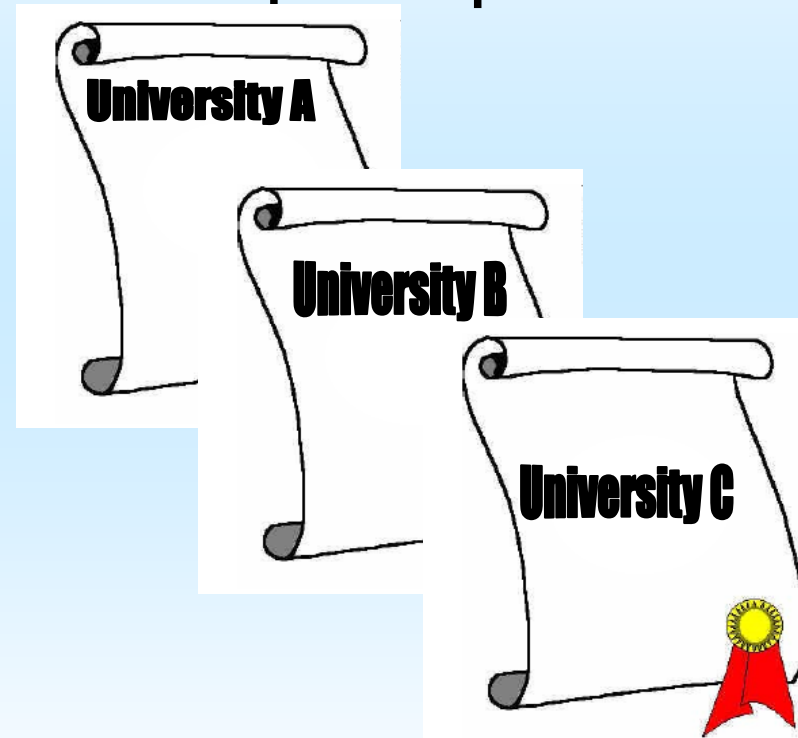
