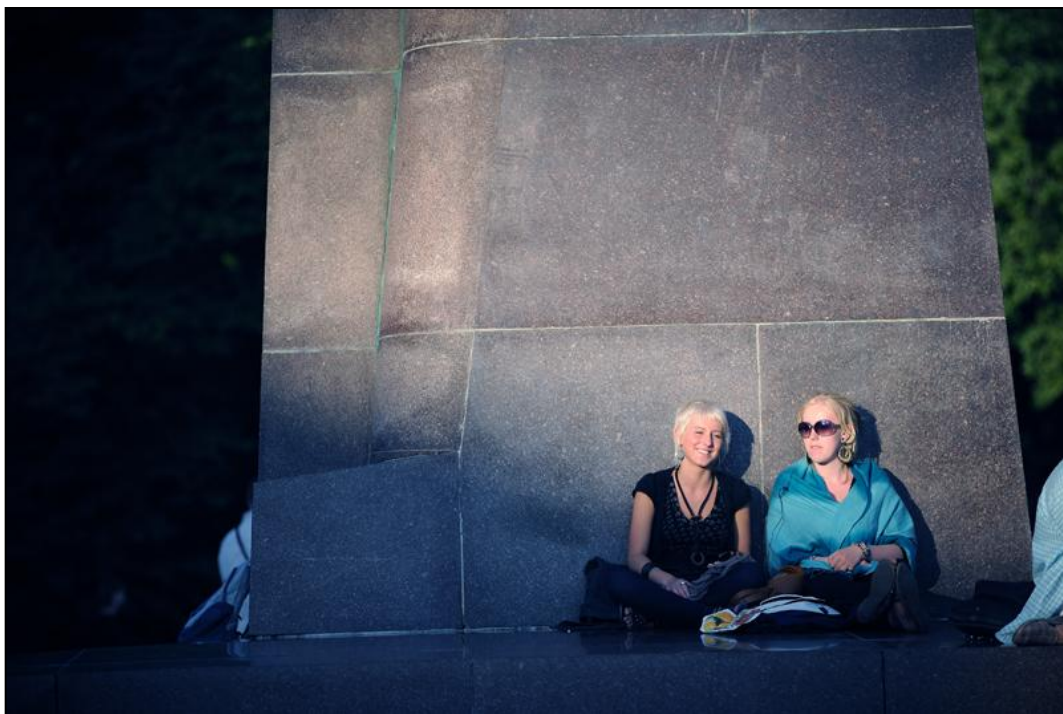

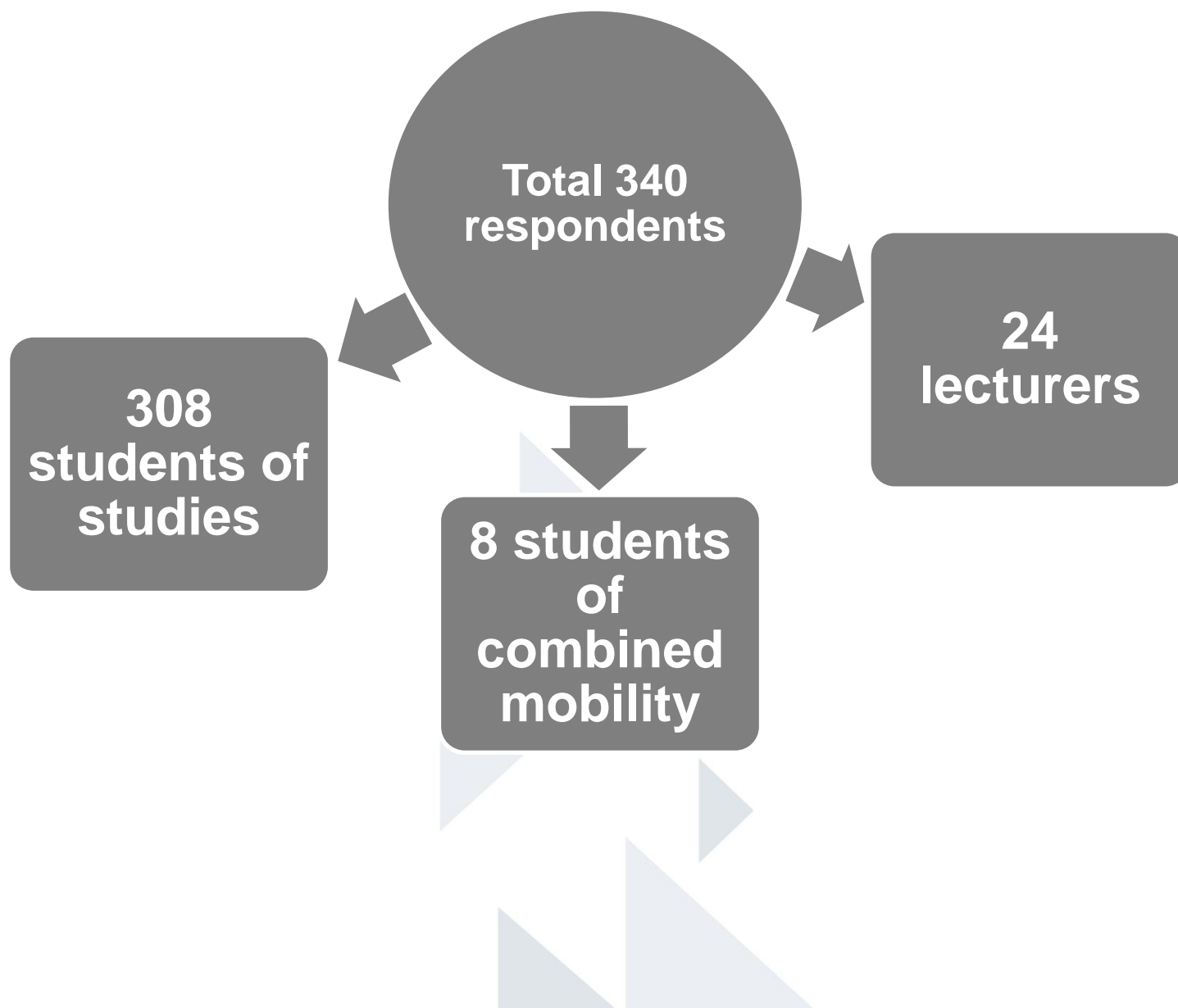

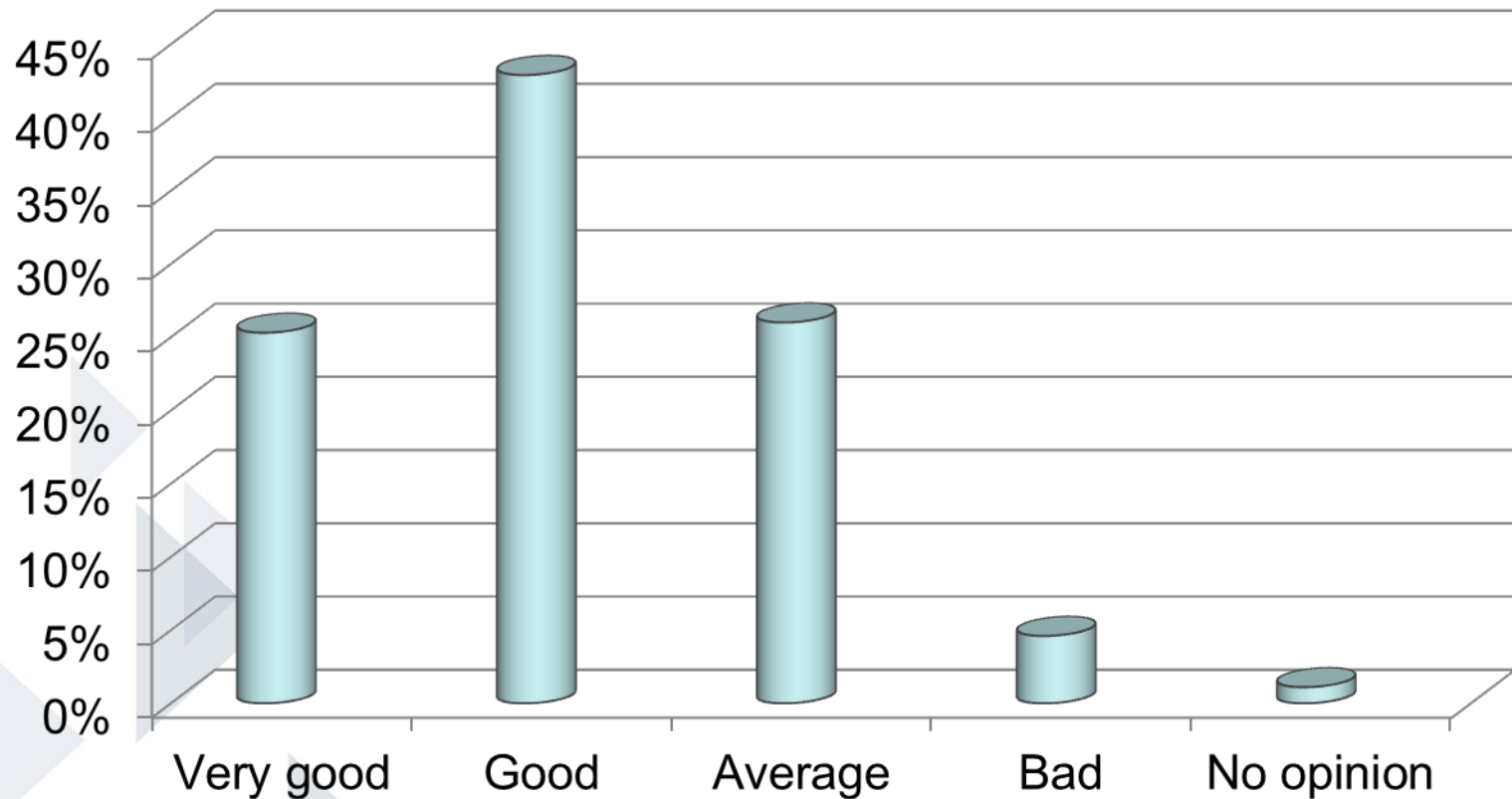
Aims and methods of the research

- To examine the opinion of **incoming** students about *Erasmus* studies/placements in Lithuania;
- Suggest recommendations to HEI;
- *Erasmus* students from 2007-2013 were surveyed;
- Methods: interview, survey and analysis of the previous survey conducted in 2006.



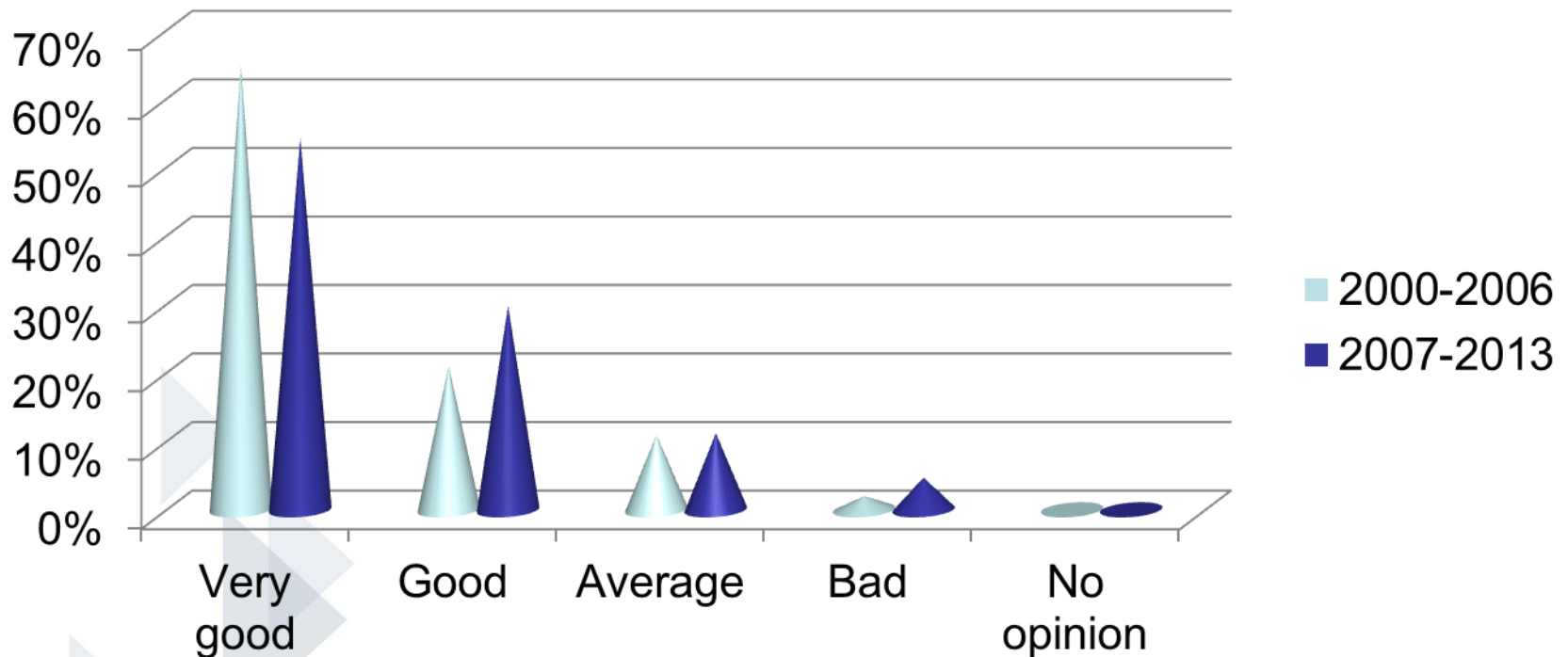

I. Quality and organization

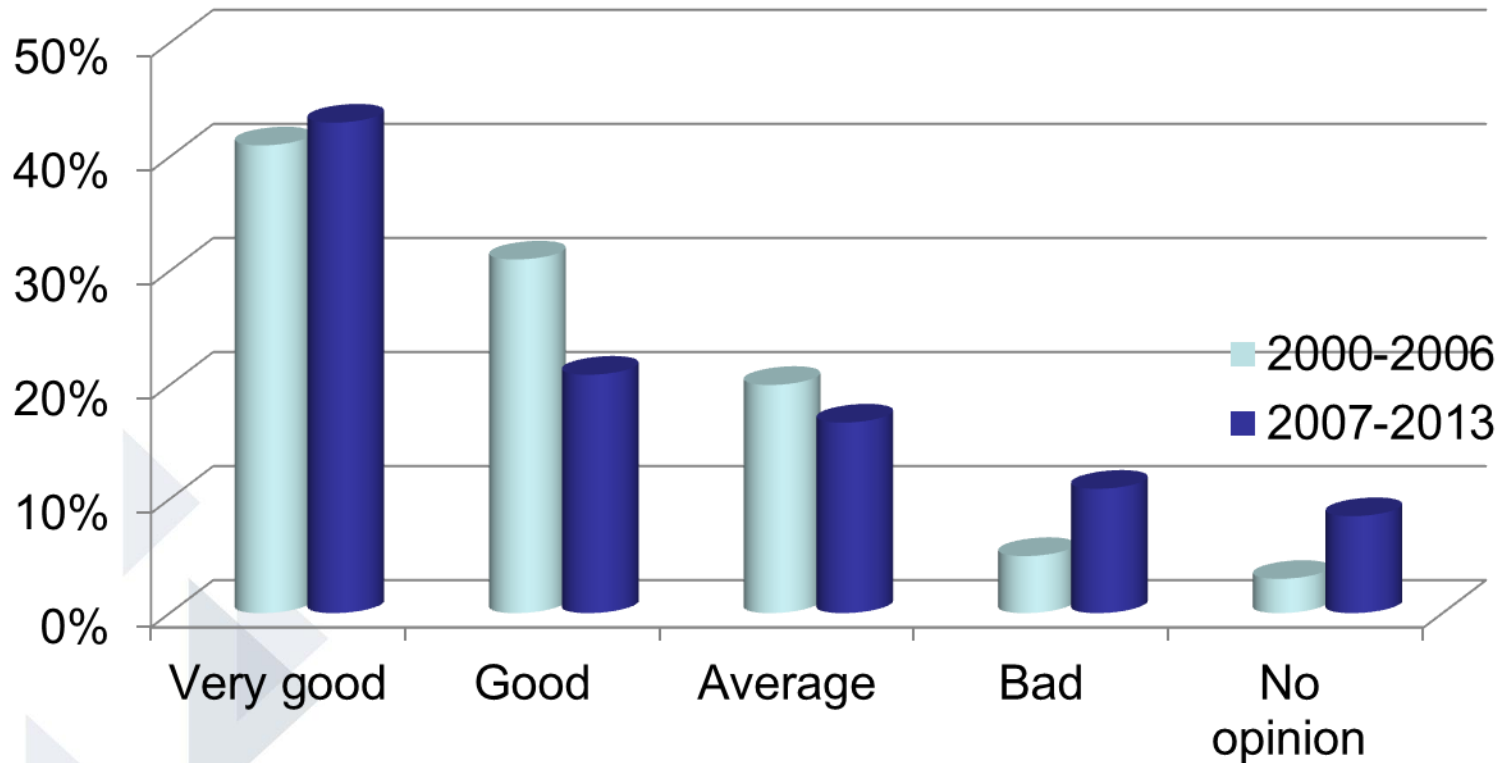
Evaluation of *Erasmus* coordinator



In comparison with 2006 - evaluation of *Erasmus* coordinator has **worsened**.

I. Quality and organization

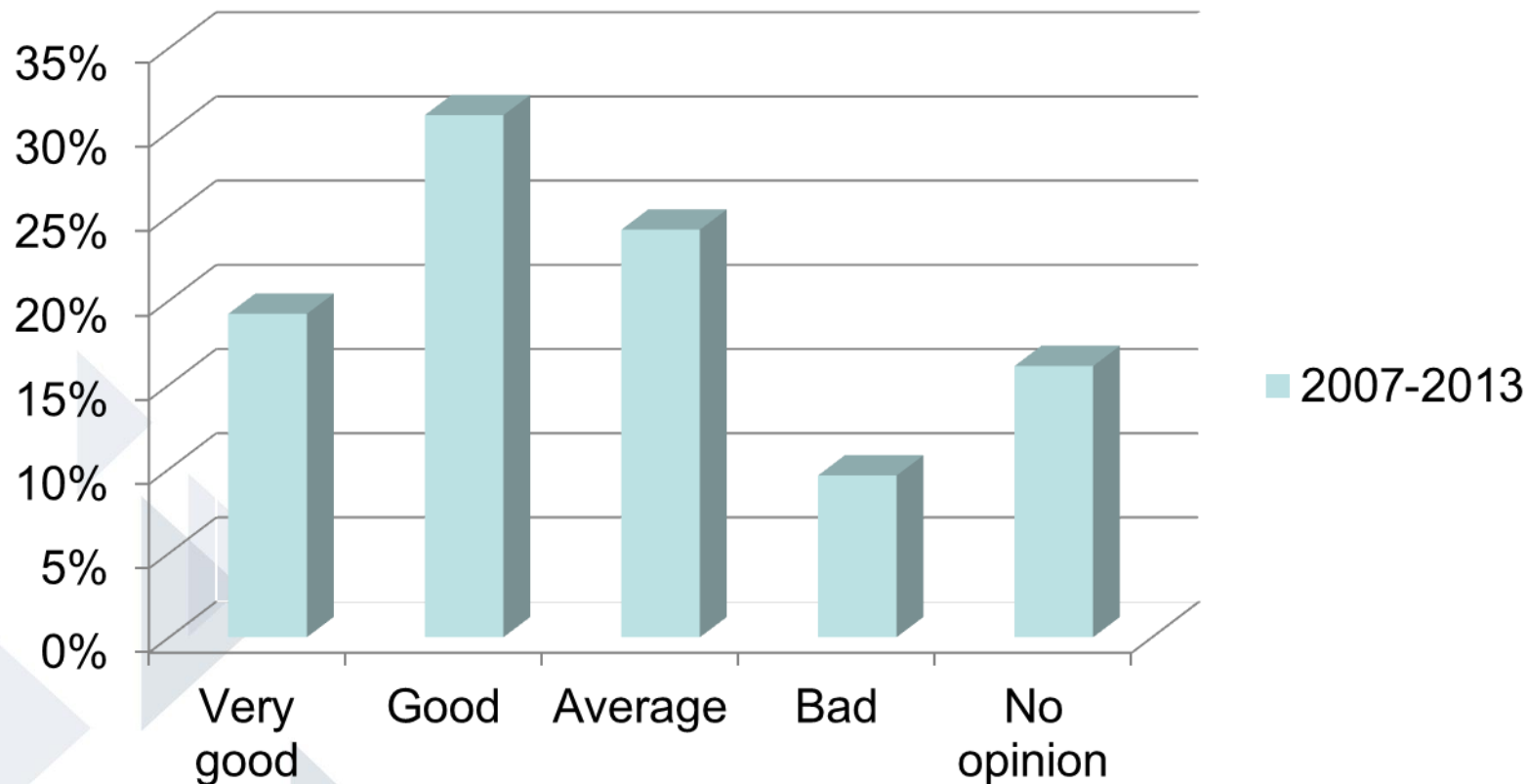
Evaluation of *Erasmus* mentor



In comparison with 2006 the general - evaluation of *Erasmus* mentor has worsened marginally

II. Social integration

Difficulties faced

- Getting medical care (26 %)
- Dealing with public officials (24%)
- Managing migration documents (18 %)
- Conducting financial operations (18%)

II. Social integration

Living conditions and social environment

- Integration in the host institution - slightly higher than average
- Communication with Lithuanians - average
- Living conditions – lower than average (especially dormitories)

III. EVALUATION OF LECTURERS

Mostly positive:

- Subject knowledge;
- Sociability and informal communication;
- Objectivity in evaluating results.

Less positive:

- Ability to transfer knowledge;
- Foreign language skills

Evaluation of lecturers has improved compared to the previous research in 2006

IV. Overall evaluation

3 most positive aspects

POSITIVE

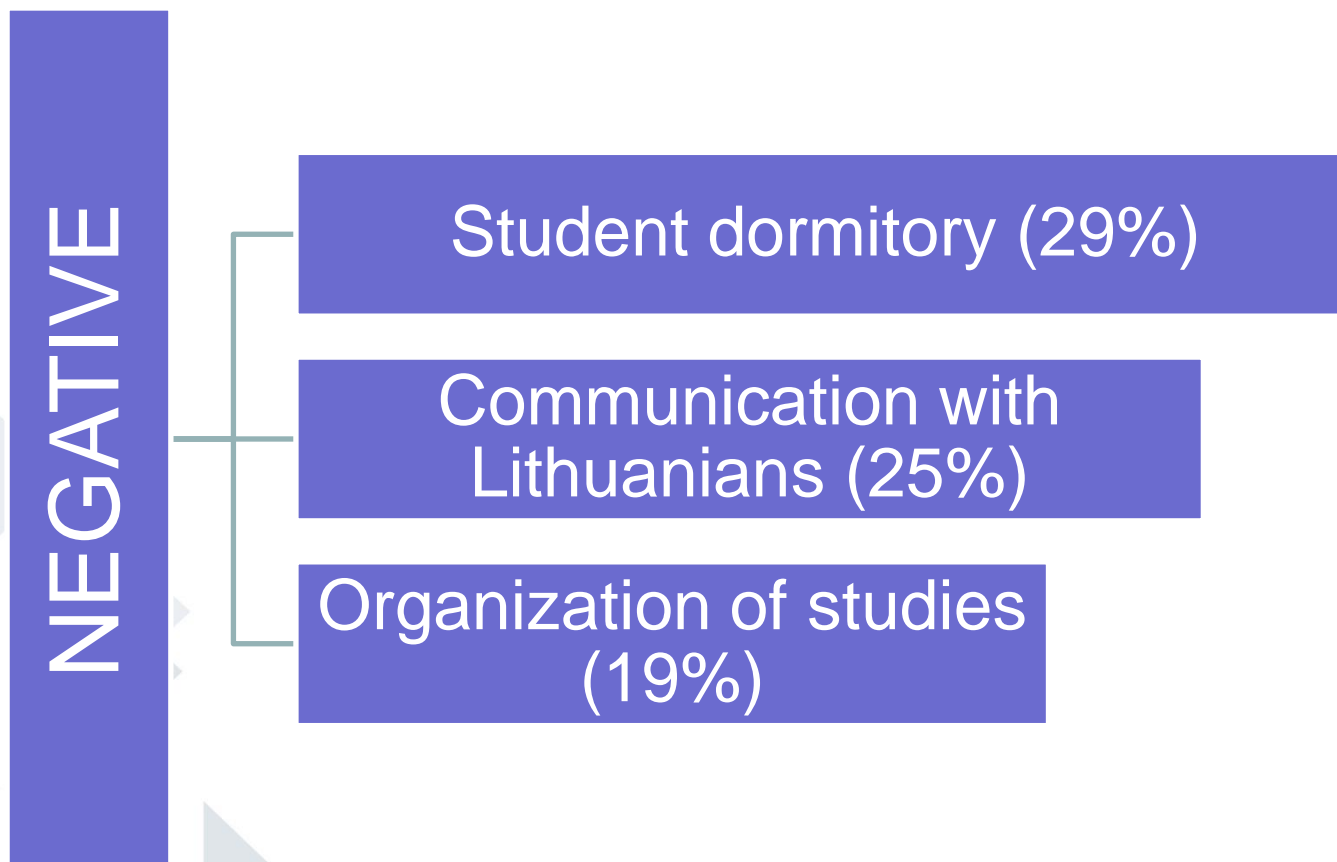
Lecturers/studies (42 %)
