
PRIMARY EDUCATION

- Children begin preschool from 5 years of age, children attend school (1st form/grade) from 6 or 7 years of age. Contact your municipal school board for information about schools in your catchment area.
- Education is compulsory until the age of 16. Personalized support is available one semester for students coming from abroad database of primary education schools*
- Bilingual programs at primary school are available in national minority and European languages (in BE, DE, ET, FR, HE, LT, PL, RU, UK)

GENERAL AND VOCATIONAL UPPER SECONDARY EDUCATION

- General upper secondary education in publicly funded schools is offered in Latvian or bilingually with national minority languages (HE, LT, PL, RU, UK) (database of general secondary schools*)
- Private upper secondary schools also offer general education in English for a fee (database of general secondary schools in English*)
- At public vocational training institutions programmes are taught in Latvian. Students may be eligible for a scholarship and a place in student housing (database of vocational schools*)
