

Eurydice

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The Eurydice network's task is to understand and explain how Europe's different education systems are organised and how they work. The network consists of 41 national units based in 37 countries (28 EU Member States, Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Montenegro, Norway, Serbia, Switzerland and Turkey) and is coordinated and managed by the EU Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency in Brussels, which drafts its publications and databases. The work of the Eurydice network is co-funded under the [Erasmus+](#) programme.
