Facts about Nordplus Higher Education

- A sector –specific sub-programme that supports educational cooperation within higher education in the Nordic and Baltic countries. Faroe Islands, Greenland and Åland are defined as countries in Nordplus
- Has one annual application round: 3rd February 2025
- Annual budget: appr. 5M€
- Supports individual mobility, intensive courses, development projects, joint study programmes and network meetings
- All activities must be connected to degree education on bachelor and master level (1st and 2nd cycles)

Who can apply to Nordplus Higher Education?

- Networks/project partnerships of higher education institutions (HEI) and other organisations. Min. 3 partners/countries (bilateral possible in mobility)
- The main target groups: students studying for a degree on bachelor or master level, academic and other staff in HEIs and other actors working with or having a strong interest within higher education.

What can you apply for in Nordplus Higher Education

Individual mobility (Erasmus + funding is recommended where applicable):

- Student mobility (1-12 month)
- Express mobility for students (1-3 weeks)
- Teacher mobility (1 day-1 month)

Projects:

- Intensive courses (1 week-1 month)
- Development projects
- Joint study programmes

Network meetings:

- Meetings for staff for establishing of new networks
- Meetings for staff for established networks
- Meetings for implementing, developing and quality assurance of Erasmus+ funded student and teacher mobility within the Nordplus network.

Funding for mobility, projects and network meetings

Individual mobility / maximum grants:

- Express mobility: 250€ 1st week (+ 100€ 2nd week, +100€ 3rd week) + travel support
- Student mobility (1-12 months): 250€/month + travel support
- Teacher mobility: 100€/day, 500€/week, 1350€/month + travel support

Intensive Courses, Development Projects and Joint Study Programmes:

- When applying: fixed unit costs for organisation, travel, subsistence, development work (not appl. for intensive courses)
- Maximum grant: 100 000€/project/contract period
- Same project can receive funding for max. 3 times in a row (3 x 100 000 €)
- Grant can be freely used on all cost items related to the implementation of the project activities ***based on real costs***

Network meetings:

- Travel and subsistence

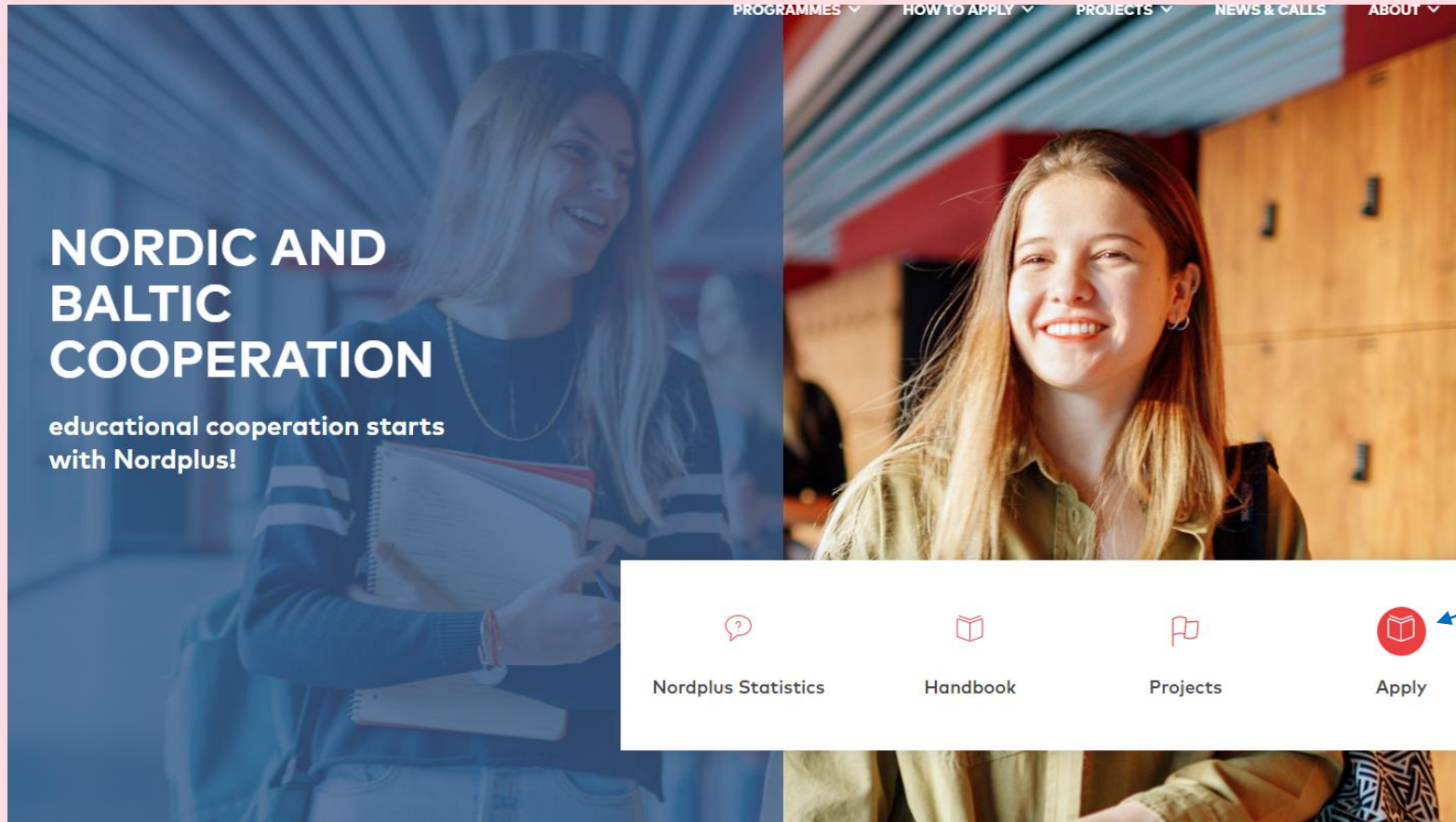


