ELIGIBILITY

- Nationals of an EU Member State
- University graduates in any field of study. For a traineeship in the Members' Chambers, a degree in law, political science, economics, or a related discipline is required
- Thorough knowledge of one official EU language and good knowledge of another; good knowledge of French or English is required
- No previous EU traineeship longer than six weeks
