It targets the international students and professionals who want to have more and deeper understanding about China. MCS engages students through participatory teaching

approaches integrating theory and practice, with an emphasis on studying the issues in contemporary China from the perspective of Chinese tradition and cross-cultural comparison. MCS enjoys the advantages of multi-disciplines at Zhejiang University, receives great support from off-campus resources in Zhejiang province from time to time and offers various kinds of opportunities to encourage students to observe and explore Chinese society themselves. Eligibility Requirements

1. The applicant should be non-Chinese citizens in good health with no infectious disease or any physical/mental diseases that may affect the normal study, and under the age of 45 in principle. 2. The applicant is required to have a good command of English and hold a bachelor's degree.

When and How to Apply

Aplication deadline: April 30th, 2015

The Applicant should first finish filling in On-line Application at the website of http://iczu.zju.edu.cn/zjdxlxszsxt/default_xs_en.jsp, and then submit the following application materials to the Admission Office (Postgraduate Programs) of the International College of Zhejiang University by post or in person.

Application Materials

1.Application Form for Admission to Zhejiang University with a recent photo (white background, 35mm×45mm in size).

The online application form should be printed and signed when completed.

2. Degree certificates, which must be original documents or notarized copies.

Documents in the languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English.

3.Academic transcripts, which must be original documents or notarized copies.

Documents in the languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized translations in Chinese or English.

- 4. English proficiency certificates (Not required for native English speakers)
- 5. A photocopy of passport.
- 6. Personal statement in Chinese or English and no less than 1000 words, which should include study and work experience, reasons for application and study proposal.
- 7. Two letters of recommendation, in Chinese or English, from full professors or associate professors. (Referee's signature, contact phone number and email address must be in the letter).
 - 8. Published academic papers or other academic achievements. (If applicable)

Note: Application materials will NOT be returned regardless of the result of the application.
