#### **Host:**

Léargas, the Irish National Agency for Erasmus+, is delighted to invite you to Dublin for a contact seminar. Dublin, the capital of Ireland, is a modern yet historic city with a medieval history and a vibrant cultural quarter. The seminar will bring together organisations working in—or seeking to work in—the field of school education and school professionals from participating European countries, who wish to explore opportunities for internationalisation in school education and learn from current good practice under Erasmus+.

### Aims:

The seminar is for participants to explore opportunities available under Erasmus+, to learn from current good practices in school education under the programme, and to gain an understanding of what works well in project partnerships. The seminar will address both School Staff Mobility (KA1) and Strategic Partnerships (KA2) projects, including School-to-School Partnerships.

## Who:

The seminar is targeted at organisations currently active in the field of School Education or seeking to become active in this field. Participants must be staff of an organisation interested in exchanging and developing good practices, and be committed to plan Erasmus+ School Education Mobility or Partnership projects.

The seminar starts at 4pm on Monday 14 November and finishes at 2pm on Wednesday 16 November.
